Risk Assessment Policy & Procedures

All clinical sessions take place in premises which have been specifically designed for the purpose of providing psychological therapy and have been inspected as safe to clients. As lone working is the norm, each session needs to be recorded in case notes.

Where there is a history of a young person has made allegations against care staff or professionals, the young person will not be seen alone, but will be seen together with a parent or carer.

Importantly, assessment of risk to clients within the home or family environment is a standard process within therapy sessions; e.g., when specific parent, teacher or carer responses to incidents of problematic child behaviour are planned, likely responses to such action by the child or young person are elucidated, and measures to ameliorate risk to self or others are integrated in the planning as part of the therapeutic process.
