NVR Certificate Course



Foundation & Advanced Courses for Winter, Spring, Summer and Autumn 2023. Online and Face to Face learning options available, with in-person training held in our London & Leeds venues.

The Certificate Course enables participants to develop the core knowledge and skills that are necessary to competently use this intervention for violence, aggression, controlling, destructive and harmful behaviour in the family, school and community.

NVR offers a unique scope and depth of training which ranges from the NVR core model to an integrated approach for working with trauma and with multi-stressed families. After successful completion of the full course (including evaluation), participants will receive the **PartnershipProjects Advanced Certificate in NVR Practice**.

Supervisor Training in NVR -



3 day course in November 2023
with 1 day Online and 2 days in-person at London venue.

Practitioners require clinical supervision to support them in their work with NVR, so they can maximise their effectiveness and safely manage risk. This can only be delivered safely by professionals who are proficient in the delivery of NVR, and who have received additional training in recognising and addressing the supervisory needs of practitioners working within the approach.

The training develops the skill-base for specific 'clinical' supervision in NVR; this is particularly necessary for workforce development, risk management and safe, competent practice: working with issues relating to aggression, violence, destructive behaviour and trauma is especially taxing to the individual frontline practitioner, who requires high-level expert support to prevent burn-out or secondary traumatisation and maintain their emotional well-being.

Delivering NVR Parent Groups using the PartnershipProjects Hybrid Format: 2-day module

This training module teaches the delivery of parent groups based on the PartnershipProjects Hybrid Parent Group format. The 2 days will focus on how participants can deliver an effective parent group which is integrated with individual family work. Instead of being a manualised programme, the Group Hybrid format aims to flexibly meet the very specific needs of each individual participating family / parent. In this way, it can have the most 'therapeutic' effects for everyone involved, by 'coaching' parents in meeting the particular challenges they face, utilising their own resources, and building their own support networks along the way. Participants will learn to apply the principles of NVR in a parent group setting, use this environment to improve parents' confidence and utilise group processes to help build their competency in resisting any harmful child behaviour long after the group work has ceased.

The highest level of NVR qualification available in the UK!



Successful Completion of the Accreditation Module (AM) makes participants eligible for accreditation with The NVR Association (NVRA); the professional body that regulates and accredits NVR practice in the UK. Individuals are then able to use the title '**NVRA Accredited Practitioner**'.

The module consists of 10 x 3 hour evening seminars that take place weekly online. Each cohort is limited to no more than 10 practitioners. In order to join, individuals should have already successfully completed the PartnershipProjects Advanced Certificate in NVR Practice.

What is SPACE?

SPACE stands for - Supportive Parenting for Anxious Childhood Emotions and is a parent-based treatment program for children and adolescents with anxiety, OCD, and related problems.

SPACE was developed by Dr. Eli Lebowitz at the Yale Child Study Center and has been tested and found to be efficacious in randomised controlled clinical trials.

Some of the main anxiety problems treated with SPACE include:

- Separation anxiety
- Social anxiety
- Generalized anxiety
- Fears and phobias
- Panic disorder and Agoraphobia
- Selective mutism
- Obsessive-compulsive disorder
